## How Do I Create a Program for My Organization?

EMC meets with you to determine what "Art Experience" will work best for your students in your facility space.

EMC will design a student registration form with you to fit your program. The form includes all the information to capture your students' interest.

## What is included by EMC?

EMC provides the instructor and any needed equipment (mats, ribbon wands, simple music instruments, etc.). Your program will provide additional instructors/assistants/parents to maintain your desired teacher/student ratios.

## How Long Are The Classes?

Age 2 years old - 30 minute class

Ages 3 - 5 years old - 45 minute class

Ages 6 and up - 1 hour class

## What is The Price?

You decide how many weeks to run the "Art Experience" for your program.

EMC charges \$10 per student per lesson (minimum of 10 students to run the session). Most organizations then add \$10 onto the total price per student to cover their own administrative and staffing costs.

For example: the cost of an 8-week session per student would be \$80 for EMC and then \$10 for your organization for a total class price of \$90.

EMC will provide a professionally taught curriculum in each of the following disciplines:

### Dance

Creative Movement & Rhythm (3-6 years old)

In this class, our youngest dancers' dreams of becoming a beautiful ballerina or a handsome prince will come to life. From the first plie, to the final curtain call on stage, our dancers will not only learn the basics of ballet and creative movement, they will also come to appreciate the joy that comes from dancing!

Dancin' for Fun (7 years old & up)

Students will rotate between Jazz, Hip Hop and Musical Theater lesson plans. This class is ideal for dancers who would like to sample a variety of dance styles in a fun, low-pressure environment. Our Hip Hop style is always appropriate for young ladies and guys. Musical Theater will give your child the chance to be dramatic, and Jazz will give aspiring dancers a taste of the traditional American dance form that started later evolved into today's Hip Hop.



### Tumbling

Children will learn cartwheels, rolls, simple vaults, hopping, jumping, landing, leaping, balancing and weight transfer on and off equipment.

### Theater

Imagine That! (4-6 year olds)

Students will use their imagination to explore their creativity as stories and fantasies come to life through dramatic play. Fun, fast-paced, and perfect for tiny performers!

Theatre Arts 1 (7-11 year olds)

Students will begin developing basic acting skills in performance, improvisation, and movement while exploring all kinds of fun in dramatic arts.

Theatre Arts 2 (12 & up)

Students will learn more advanced acting techniques and develop skills while studying all aspects of theatre. Classes will focus on the importance of character development, the actor's movement, and game playing while learning.



### Music Play

Students will be introduced to basic rhythm skills using rudimentary instruments to reinforce the essentials of music development. Students will also be guided in vocal exercises and songs to explore the melodic characteristics of music.
