KREATIVE KIDZ DANCE PROGRAM

The Pre-dance program at EMC is an age-appropriate introduction to the fundamentals of ballet, tap and jazz. These core classes provide the perfect balance of creative lesson plans and a structured routine resulting in the optimal start to your child's dance training.

These classes will help prepare your child for performance in the professional venue, The Pullo Center in June 2012. Classes are kept small to ensure individualized attention.

Creative Movement & Rhythm (ages 3-4) Tues 5:00-5:45	In this class, our youngest dancers' dreams of becoming a beautiful ballerina or a handsome prince will come to life. From the first plie, to the final curtain call on the last day of class, our dancers will not only learn the basics of ballet and tap, they will also come to appreciate the joy that comes from dancing!	\$96	Cinderella (ages 4-7) July 11-15 July 25-29 \$100
Ballet & Tap Basics (ages 5-6) Tues 6:00-6:50	As our tiny dancers grow more confident, they are taught more structured movements, including proper stretching techniques, positions of the feet and arms, locomotor skills and simple jumps. Our students are encouraged to respect the classroom, their fellow dancers and the art of dance!	\$96	Acting Up! (ages 4-7) July 18-22 \$100
Dance Foundations (ages 6-8) Tues 6:30-8:00	This is a transition class that acts as a bridge between the Kreative Kidz Program and the Technique Program. At this level, dancers will be expected to adapt to the hour and a half spent in the studio with discipline and focus. More mature dance concepts are developed, such as port de bras (arm movements), proper posture, articulation of the feet as well as more complex patterns of movement. Gymnastics for Dancers (ages 6-9) Tues 5:15-6:00	Choreographers often ask their dancers to perform basic tumbling skills as a part of a dance piece. This class will give young dancers instruction on how to perform cartwheels, handstands, front and back walkovers and aerials. Dancers who have these skills are often highlighted in dance choreography, so give YOUR dancer an opportunity to stand out and be hi-lighted! Hip Hop (ages 5-8) Thurs 5:00-5:50	In this class, your child will learn the latest moves set to fun, funky pop music. Hip Hop is often seen in music videos, but at EMC, the movement style is always appropriate for young dancers. Our instructors teach an athletic style that is upbeat and teaches rhythm, coordination, team work and encourages dancers to pick up more complex choreography.	\$96	Pop Star Camp (ages 7-11) July 18-22 \$180

DANCIN' FOR FUN PROGRAM

This program is ideal for students who are looking for quality instruction but only have an hour per week to dedicate to dance. Affordable tuition, convenient schedules and fully equipped studios make this program appealing to the busiest families. This is a recreational class and is not intended to prepare dancers for serious dance training.

Tumble Bugs (18months-3 years old) Mon 5:30-6:00	In this class, our youngest students playfully learn to move over, under, through, around and on apparatus in a safe manner. The main focus of this class is to increase the child's body awareness through movement and to develop a sense of his/her surroundings in terms of sharing space. The parent is a facilitator of the child's movement discoveries. For safety reasons, siblings are not permitted in the instructional area. For students ages 18-24 months, parent participation is required, while for students ages 2-3 years old, parent participation may be optional with instructor's approval	\$80	N/A
Tumble Weeds (3-4 years old) Mon 6:15-7:00	This class is appropriate for the child who demonstrates a definite independence from the parent, has an adequate attention span and the ability to follow simple directions. <p>Tumble Tykes (5-6 years old)</p> <p>Mon 7:15-8:15 or Wed 5:30-6:30</p>	<p>In this class, students are asked to challenge themselves both physically and mentally. Children work on spacial awareness, listening skills, and the form and technique needed to conquer more difficult movement challenges. Cartwheels, round-offs, front headrolls, handstands, vault, bars and beam are explored.</p>		
<p>Levels 1, 2 & 3 (Ages 7-14)</p> <p>Wed 6:45-8:15</p>	<p>This in an introductory program of gymnastics and tumbling. Flexibility, strength and technique are emphasized. Skills include forward rolls, backward rolls, handstands, cartwheels, round-offs, walk-overs and other basic moves on the beam, bars and vault.</p> <p>In this intermediate level class, our most skilled gymnasts will incorporate power into their movements to further perfect their technique.
